“tch” sounds like /ch/ and always follows a short vowel

Six common exception words are:
rich, which, such, much, ostrich, sandwich

duck

“ck” sounds like /k/ and always follows a short vowel
(in one-syllable words and in compound words)



Lesson #17

lamb

The “b” is silent when “mb” is in one-syllable words or comes together in a syllable. “Mb” can change the sound of the vowel that it follows.
